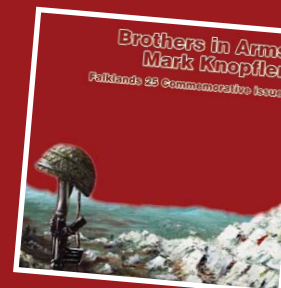


## Brothers in Arms by Mark Knopfler

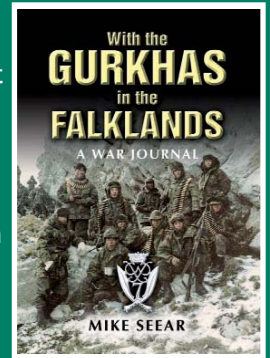
